Taking place during *Indian Market* weekend is a series of panel discussions in partnership with the Native American Rights Fund (NARF) that will happen both Saturday and Sunday on the Plaza stage. There will be a number of topics discussed with NARF attorneys and artists, with a focus toward art and activism. SWAIA Chief Operating Officer Dallin Maybee explains, "The undercurrent is always going to be arts and activism. The ways the art has been a vehicle for being a voice for Native American communities, oftentimes when we haven't had one."
